

THE PRISONERS ON LÅNGHOLMEN

-Prisoner for a day, captivated for life!

A captivating game:

The suspected criminals are conveyed by the guards to "Långholmen's Court"! The Court is located in the cellar of the old Spin House. Our judge is not often merciful to felons and the sentence is usually life in Långholmen Prison. When the sentence is passed, it is time for washing, change of clothes (stripped) and registration.

One chance for freedom still remains... if the prisoners manage to collect a bail that is set at 700,000 riksdaler. The prisoners split up into different gangs, for example Jailbirds, Squealers and the Beagle Boys, who compete against each other. Each gang is given their own empty moneybag to collect money and a game plan. The gang leader decides who is best suited to carry out each task. At each station there is a screw/station host (a person from your group). The screws are tough but corrupt and can hand out points for style. Thus, it is a question of charming the screws, perhaps with a protest song or the prisoners go smartly in line.

When the gang has tried all the stations, ca. seven, it is once again time to meet the Judge. (During the summer, most of the stations are outdoors.) The gang that succeeds in collecting the bail, gathered the most style points as well as answered the most chance questions correctly wins. In the Finken pub, it is now appropriate to offer the thirsty prisoners "bread and water", choose the strength after your own taste. (Not included in the price.) The game itself takes about two hours.

The event is concluded with a prison party, still dressed in stripes, in one of our pleasant locales. It is usually exciting here to find out how it went for the different gangs, maybe the winning team will also sing their protest song!

Price: 786 SEK/person excl. VAT. Minimum game charge, 25 persons á 408 SEK.
